**Year 11 Leavers Celebration Evening/Art and Photography Showcase**

We are planning our Year 11 School Leaver Celebration/Awards Evening a little bit differently this year. The evening will be held on **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2023 in the Sports Hall**. It will be an opportunity to welcome people back into the Sports Hall after its long closure. It is also a fantastic opportunity for the Art and Photography department to showcase the work of their GCSE pupils from 2023 in an exhibition. The evening will also allow pupils to collect awards that they have been nominated for, and their GCSE certificates.

The evening is planned to be less formal than previous years. Light refreshments will be served on the evening, and it is hoped that every pupil who studied Art and Photography will have work on display to view.
