Year 11 Pupils - The College Application Process

The college application process has been launched this week; first applications should be made before we break up for Christmas in December. This will help ensure our pupils are high on the list of available places for their preferred course and college. Time has been made available during registration each week to dedicate to researching and making college applications, pupils should be prepared to continue this at home. Information and college prospectuses are available in school and can be brought home to help pupils with their research. Applications should be made online for each provider and pupils can apply for as many colleges and courses as they wish. Pupils are encouraged to make more than one application and make their final choice once they have received their GCSE results in August. Those pupils looking for an apprenticeship should also complete a college application, most of our local college have apprenticeship programme and can offer support and guidance in finding the right apprenticeship opportunity for you child.

To assist pupils their decision making, I will be continuing to will meet with each pupil during the school day to discuss their careers aspirations and provide any support or guidance they may need at this transitional stage.
