Re: End of Year 11 Arrangements

As we near the end of GCSE examinations, we would like to congratulate Year 11 on their positive attitude towards their GCSE studies. We have been extremely impressed by their hard work and delighted with the number of pupils who have engaged in our after-school revision programme. We would also like to take this opportunity to inform you of the end of term arrangements for our pupils. Firstly, we would like to celebrate the achievements of our Year 11 pupils by holding our traditional leavers event on Tuesday 10th June 2025.

All pupils will be required to bring in two shirts for the Leavers' event. One shirt is typically used for the traditional shirt signing. However, our formal leavers' photographs and the assembly require pupils to wear a plain shirt. We also require all pupils to wear their blazer during the photographs and for the assembly.

Timing	Event Details on Tuesday 10 th June
8.45am	Registration and Breakfast in the Main Hall – Bacon and sausage sandwiches will be provided in addition to other options to cater for all dietary needs.
9.15am	A carousel of revision sessions within the Maths Department will take place preparing pupils for their examination on the morning of Wednesday 11 th June 2025.
11.00am	Lunch and opportunities for shirt signing.
11.35am	Return to form rooms for a short farewell with Form Tutors
11.50am	All pupils to go to the main field for form photographs and the official leavers' photographs
12.40pm	All Year 11 pupils to go to the Sports Hall for their Leavers' Assembly.
1.15pm	The day will end at approximately 1.15pm. Pupils will be allowed to leave the school site to go home. Pupils should make their own arrangements to travel home. Alternatively, the school can provide a space on the school site for any pupils to work independently if arrangements to get home cannot be made. Once pupils have left the school site, they will not be allowed to return to the site.

From Wednesday 11th June, pupils will only be expected to be in school when they have examinations. Pupils need to wear their school uniform when in school for their examinations and revision sessions. Pupils can leave site once any examinations have finished. We will also be hosting some additional revision sessions in school which pupils can opt to attend, these are as follows:

- Wednesday 11th June – Geography Revision 1.15pm to 3.15pm
- Thursday 12th June – Chemistry Revision 1.15pm to 3.15pm
- Friday 13th June – Physics Revision 1.15pm to 3.15pm
- Tuesday 17th June – Design & Technology and Food Revision 9.15am to 11.15am.

From Tuesday 10th June, pupils who are attending the school for examinations and revision sessions will be allowed to leave the site between these sessions. Any pupil wishing to remain on site, or those who would prefer revising in school can do so. A quiet space will be set aside for these pupils.

Every year, we take the opportunity to invite Year 11 pupils to **donate uniform items** to boost our pre-loved uniform stock. We welcome any donations of blazers, ties, and PE kit (including any footwear in good condition). We also welcome donations of scientific calculators. All items can be handed in to reception.

Pupils who have borrowed **revision guides, textbooks and Chromebooks need to return all items to the school by Friday 13th June**. These should be handed in to Reception.

All Year 11 pupils are required to **empty their locker** on the date of their final exam. Keys should be returned to Reception and in return pupils will be returned their £2 deposit.

It is important that parents pay close attention to their child's **lunch account**. Any monies remaining on account after the final exam has been completed will be refunded. **Parents must also ensure that any accounts that are overdrawn are settled by Friday 20th June 2024**.

The Prom is rapidly approaching with today being the deadline for purchasing Prom tickets. We will extend this deadline until Wednesday 11th June to allow the remaining tickets to be purchased. We will write to you separately with specific details regarding this event.

Finally, thank you for your consistent support throughout your child's time at The Snaith School. We wish all our Year 11 pupils the best of luck in their upcoming examinations, and we look forward to welcoming pupils back to The Snaith School on results day in August and again in the Autumn term to our annual celebration event.
