## Re: End of Year 11 Arrangements

As we near the start of GCSE examinations, we would like to congratulate Year 11 on their positive attitude towards their GCSE studies. We have been extremely impressed by their hard work and delighted with the number of pupils who have engaged in our after-school and lunchtime revision programme. To date, Year 11 pupils have collectively attended over 4000 hours of revisions sessions which is testament to their outstanding attitudes to learning.

Our revision programme will continue to run during this summer's series of examinations. A comprehensive summary of the exams and revision sessions can be found <u>here</u>. This will be updated in the coming weeks to include the revision sessions taking place after Half-Term.

All pupils are invited to the revision sessions, and we strongly recommend that they attend. The purpose of these sessions is to complement your child's independent revision and to provide last minute advice and guidance for each examination.

We appreciate that some pupils struggle with transportation and that this can be a barrier to attending the after-school revision sessions. As you will be aware, the school has recently taken delivery of a minibus. We will be offering transportation home for pupils who live in Whitley and Eggborough or the villages served by either the Pollington Bus, 22S or the SW3. This route has been prioritised due to the lack of public transport provision when travelling west of Snaith. We would also like to take this opportunity to inform you of the end of term arrangements for our pupils. Firstly, we would like to celebrate the achievements of our Year 11 pupils by holding our traditional leavers event on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2025. This will take place after a morning revision session in preparation for the Maths exam on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2025. There will be opportunities for pupils to sign each other's shirts but we ask that all pupils bring two shirts to school on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> May. One which can be signed and one to remain unsigned for the benefit of the formal leavers' photos.

	have left the school site, they will <b>not</b> be allowed to return to the site.

GCSE examinations started on Tuesday 6th May and all Year 11 pupils are expected to attend school as normal until <u>Tuesday 10th June</u>. When not sitting an examination, pupil's are expected to attend their normal timetabled lessons. The afternoon of Monday 9th June will be the last day following their normal timetable unless they are sitting the PE or Creative iMedia examinations. From Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> June, pupils will only be expected to be in school when they have examinations.

Every year, we take the opportunity to invite Year 11 pupils to **donate uniform items** to boost our preloved uniform stock. We welcome any donations of blazers, ties, and PE Kit (including any footwear in good condition). We also welcome donations of scientific calculators. All items can be handed into reception.

Pupils who have borrowed **revision guides**, **textbooks and Chromebooks need to return all items to the school by Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> June.** These should be handed into Reception.

All Year 11 pupils are required to **empty their locker** on the date of their final exam. Keys should be returned to Reception and in return students will be returned their deposit of £2.

It is important that parents pay close attention to their child's **lunch account**. Any monies remaining on account after the final exam has been completed will be refunded. **Parents must also ensure that any accounts that are overdrawn are settled by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2025.** 

Finally, thank you for your consistent support throughout your child's time at The Snaith School. We wish all our Year 11 pupils the best of luck in their upcoming examinations, and we look forward to welcoming pupils back to The Snaith School on results day in August and again in the Autumn term to our annual celebration event.
