## Dear Parent/Carer,

On Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> July, the school has organised an event run by 'We are a Knockout'. All pupils will be invited to the event during the school day.

All activities take place in Form Rooms unless stated.

In form groups, pupils have been organising various themes for fancy dress as part of the Knockout Event. We must stress that clothing worn underneath any fancy dress items have appropriate levels of body coverage with a minimum of normal length PE type shorts and full-length T-Shirt. Pupils will also need to ensure they wear trainers which may get wet. Normal expectations will remain in place for make-up, jewellery, lashes and false nails due to health and safety.

We anticipate some pupils will need to change after the event, so we ask all pupils to bring a full change of sports clothing. We do not require pupils to wear their PE Kit due to Friday 19<sup>th</sup> July being Sports Day. <u>All pupils are required to wear full PE Kit on Sports Day</u>.

For your child to be allowed to participate in the Knockout Event, parents and carers must read and agree to the Code of Practice which can be viewed <u>here</u>. Parents and carers will then be required, through the Arbor Parent App, to tick the consent box for this event in the trips section of the application.

To do this, parents must have downloaded and logged into the Arbor Parent App using the instructions sent out previously by e-mail. Once logged in, parents/carers need to navigate to the trips section of the app and then to the 'Trips open to your child'. From here, select the Knockout event and click the green 'Sign Up' button and then tick the consent box followed by clicking the green button to 'add consent'. By ticking this box, you are consenting for your child to participate and that you agree fully to the code of practice for the event. Pupils can opt out of the event if they choose and can spectate within their form group.

We anticipate this will be a fantastic day, thoroughly enjoyed by both pupils and staff. We intend to create a later edition of the Newsletter to share with you some of the images from the day and from Sports Day.
