Visit to Coventry Cathedral January 30th, 2026

The RE, Philosophy and Ethics Department are offering an opportunity for Year 11 pupils to visit the Community of the Cross of Nails at Coventry Cathedral. This trip will enhance the Christianity module and will give pupils an opportunity to discuss peace and reconciliation. The Cathedral was heavily bombed in WWII and has since become the centre of a worldwide movement towards forgiveness and reconciliation.

Pupils should wear full school uniform. They will also require a pen, notebook or exercise book, their planner and a packed lunch. We will leave school at 8.15am and return to school for approximately 4.30pm. I stress the need for responsible behaviour at all times and welcome your support in reinforcing this message at home.

There are 14 places available only, as we will be taking the school minibus. Should you wish your child to take part, please confirm an expression of interest by completing the Microsoft Form below **by Friday 14th November**. If we have more than 14 expressions of interest, a draw will be held.

In order to cover the cost of the trip a voluntary contribution of £20 per pupil is requested. This can be made via Scopay once your child has received confirmation of their place on the trip. Under the School Governors Charging Policy there is no obligation to contribute and pupils will be treated the same whether or not a contribution has been received. However, failure to receive sufficient contributions could put financial restraints on other activities within this subject area and may lead to the trip not going ahead.

For pupils who are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, school are able to cover this cost.
