**WeCompose Composition Project Introductory Concert with the Ligeti Quartet Wednesday 24 January**

The Year 10 GCSE Music class and selected musicians from Year 9 are invited to participate in a composition project run by Music in the Round and facilitated by the East Riding Music Hub.

This innovative project introduces young people from all backgrounds to composition. Students will be supported by emerging and professional composers to create their own music which will be performed by professional musicians. Young composers will become critical, reflective and collaborative members of creative communities. The project aims to inspire young people to not only consider studying the arts in the future, but to see it as a possible career, so the next generation of artists is more reflective of our diverse society.

Students are invited to an introductory concert performed by the Ligeti String Quartet at 1:30pm on Wednesday 24 January at Junction in Goole. Year 10 students will have their lunch as normal and Year 9 students will have their lunch at the earlier time of 11:15am (during their usual break time) so that they can attend the majority of period three, before we depart at 12:30pm. We will be leaving school at 12:30pm. The concert will last for an hour and students will be return to school for the end of the day.

In the coming months there will also be 3 school visits from a professional composer and on Wednesday 12 June there will be a daytime WeCompose culmination concert with the Ligeti Quartet at the Junction in Goole.

This is a fantastic opportunity for our students to gain valuable experience in the music industry.
