Dear Parent/Carer,

The Snaith School is running an **Italian cultural trip to Rome from 12**<sup>th</sup>-**15**<sup>th</sup> **April 2025**. Priority has been given to pupils studying RE and/or Food Technology, however we have a small number of places left and so are opening the opportunity to all Year 10 pupils. If you would like to give your child the opportunity to take part in this trip, the details are given below:

**Departure:** Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2025 (Times TBC) **Return:** Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> April 2025 (Times TBC)

Cost: £950 Tour Operator: WST Next Generation Travel Group

The programme of activities includes a visit to the Vatican City to include St Peter's Basilica, the Vatican Museum and the Sistine Chapel, a visit to the Colosseum, Roman Forum and Palatine Hill, a visit to the Jewish Museum and Synagogues as well as a pizza making class and a food walking tour.

The cost of the visit includes travel, breakfast and evening meal, accommodation and all excursions. Pupils will need to bring some spending money for lunch and souvenirs etc. As we are booking the trip well in advance to allow for payments to be made monthly, the flights cannot yet be booked. It may be that upon booking, the price is slightly lower than expected and if this is the case, hoodies will be included in the cost of the trip and any further surplus returned to parents. Flights currently are expected to be with Ryan Air, and a **small** cabin bag is allowed in the cost of the flight. Overhead locker and hold baggage attract an additional cost of approximately £80 and should your child wish to take this option, it would be advisable to share with friends and split the cost.

If you would like your child to have the opportunity to take part in this trip, please fill in the expression of interest form and hand in to Mrs Kears or Miss Scott with no payment by Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2023. Please note, returning the expression of interest does not guarantee a place on the trip. There are a maximum of 40 places available for pupils. Once your child has secured a place, a deposit of £175 for the trip must be received no later than Monday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2024, with a further payment of £150 to be received by Monday 5<sup>th</sup> February 2024 (Please note the deposit figure is set by the travel company and not the school). The rest of the cost can be paid monthly with all funds to be received by 10<sup>th</sup> January 2025 and an online payment system will be set up to facilitate this. Please note, we anticipate this trip to be very popular. Should we have more expressions of interest than places available, we will draw out names in order to ensure fairness to all.

If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, we will offer a contribution towards the cost of the trip. Please contact <u>accounts@thesnaithschool.org.uk</u> for more information.
