As we move closer to the exam season, I would like to share some important information regarding upcoming events and crucial dates for our Year 11 pupils as they gear up for the summer GCSE exams.

Homework Timetable: Spring Term

Please find a link to the homework timetable available on the school website. Homework plays an important part in your child's preparation for the summer exams, and we ask that you encourage your child to stay up to date with homework tasks.

As well as containing information about homework for all subjects and deadlines for the homework, there is also a breakdown of revision topics week by week to enable your child to revise in a systematic and organised manner and for you to be able to support your child at home. All pupils in Year 11 will be given a hard copy this week.

Revision menu: Please follow the link to view the revision sessions we are offering pupils, including after school revision run by staff. These after school revision sessions will commence w/b 24th February.

Period 6 sessions (after school revision) also begin immediately after half term. We advise that pupils attend at least two core subjects (English, maths, science) a week and an option subject each week.

All pupils in Year 11 will be given a hard copy this week of the menu, we recommend that you keep a copy of this to hand so that you are aware of the timetable.

Revision sessions will also be running during lunchtime by some subject areas, again we recommend that pupils attend these.

In some cases, Period 6 sessions will be compulsory for some pupils. Parents of those pupils will be notified separately.

5 o'clock Club Monday to Thursday. This was very popular before and during the mock exams and continues to be so. It's a perfect place for quiet, individual revision and somewhere where homework and coursework and be completed. Please note that on Tuesday the room is closed at 4.30pm.

Form time Boosters/Intervention (English, Maths and Science)

You will have already been informed if your child is involved in any of these sessions.
