Year 11 Raising Achievement Programme: Autumn Term

We are writing to inform you of the raising achievement programme for Year 11 pupils this half term. The first of these is the 'Steps to Success' evening on Wednesday 12th November 2025, 4.30pm – 7.00pm.

The purpose of the evening is to offer practical advice as to how you can support your child's revision and preparation for their GCSE examinations in the run-up to mock exams in December and preparation for next summer's exams.

The evening will consist of a series of revision workshops for English, Maths and Science, revision stands for all other subjects and an opportunity for you, as parents/carers, to receive some practical advice on revision techniques, revision guides and the content of exams.

All pupils will receive a revision 'goody bag' which includes a range of materials to aid their revision at home.
