Last year, we organised for pupils to have access to an online revision platform and app called Tassomai. This is a fantastic resource and is a useful tool to help with revision for English, Maths and Science. Tassomai aims to help pupils develop subject knowledge and focuses upon retrieval practice. We have relaunched the platform to all Year 11 pupils again this week, and we are pleased to also be able to offer French and Computer Science to those who have these as an option this year.

From Monday 16th September 2024, as a minimum requirement, pupils will be expected to complete 100% of their weekly goal (or 30 mins per week) for each of their subjects on Tassomai. In maths, this is not compulsory as pupils will complete 45 minutes of a past paper instead, however pupils should engage with Maths on Tassomai as a revision tool.

Last year, you should have received a request from <u>Wonde</u> to connect with Tassomai. If you accepted this request, you have given Tassomai permission to access your email address. In doing so, you will receive a weekly progress report each Monday morning. Please see the example below.

Each week, you will receive an email that gives you access to your own personalised parent dashboard, where you can monitor your child's usage and activity on Tassomai. You can also see their recommended resources and their "Trees". The Tree is a visual depiction of your child's usage. The leaves indicate a particular topic, the size of the leaf indicates how much time your child has spent on that topic. The colour of the leaf indicates how much they have understood. A green leaf therefore, indicates secure knowledge, whilst an amber or red leaf illustrates an area of focus for your child. Please see the following link for further help & support:
